



TRANSFER PHOTOS FROM YOUR PHONE TO WINDOWS 11 OVER USB

First connect your phone to your Windows 11 PC using a USB cable.


1. Open the Photos app on your PC by **opening the Start menu** and **typing "Photos"** (in the field circled in **red** below) until the app appears, before **left-clicking the app icon**.



2. Left-Click the import icon in the top-right (circled in **red** below).




3. Left-click on your device's name in the **popup list** as show below.



4. Your PC will now scan your phone for photos and videos. This may take a while, depending on how many pictures and videos you have on your phone.




5. Once your phone has been scanned, you'll see preview of your photos and videos appear in the Photos app. You can **select the files you want to import** by **left-clicking the check box on individual photos** (circled in **blue** above), or **left-clicking the check box on Select new** (circled in **red** above). Now **left-click on the “Add xxx items” button** (circled in **green** above) to see the following popup:




6. The imported pictures will be saved directly under your Pictures folder unless you make a change. If you have a folder, you wish the imported pictures to be saved in, **left-click on the link** (circled in **red** above) under “Choose a folder”. The link will expand to show all the folders listed under your Pictures folder. **Left-click on the folder** you want to use and it will now display on the link. **You may now go to Step 9 unless you wish to create a new folder.**

7. If you need to create a new folder, **left-click on the “Create folder” link** (circled in **blue** above) to see the following:



8. **Left-click in the folder field** (circled in **red** above) and type in the name for the new folder. Now **left-click on the “Create” button** (circled in **blue** above) and the display will be as follows (I created a new folder “My Phone Pictures”):



9. Now left-click on the “Import” button (circled in **blue** above) and the imported pictures will be saved in your folder.
